Welcome to the September CSMD Newsletter. July and August have been very busy months for us, but things are starting to settle down again. In this month's newsletter we recap on the features of CSMD Advanced 1.2.

CSMD Advanced 1.2:

CSMD Advanced 1.2 has been on general release for a couple of months now, and we have had some excellent feedback. However because of the nature of the company we will always try to add features that are suggested by our customers. So onto the features, well with both versions of CSMD you get two channel fading, which can be increased to a 3rd channel if you use the build in CD Player. You also have the master fader, cross faders and pan faders as you would expect to find on a normal mixing desk. From this point onwards the advantages of using a computerised system become more apparent. Setting up playlists allows you to make sure that at the click of a button you load all the tracks you need in the right order with the appropriate settings. Playlists are simple, just add a track, set the settings and away you go. This is really useful if your sound operator is still learning the ropes, because all they need to do is press PLAY at the right cue, and the system will manage everything else. i.e. The Fade In, Fade out, start point, end point. This means you can get a high level of precision into your production, but with the flexibility to adapt as you go. If there are times you need to pre mix a couple of tracks together then CSMD can do this too. Simply record the output, using the built in recording facility, and then import this recorded track into a playlist. In fact everything is so simple in CSMD you will be mixing up more advanced creations all the time. Another amazing feature is the portable playlists. This allows you to sit in the comfort of your own home, and setup your playlists with all the features. Pop the playlist onto a memory stick or external hard drive and take it to your venue, where you can run it with exactly the same features as you setup at home. Simple and easy!

With the development of CSMD Advanced 1.2 additional licences are available for our most popular CSMD range, the CSMD Advanced products. So if you already have a licence for CSMD Advanced you can now buy an additional one for £10. This allows you to have another installation of CSMD Advanced running elsewhere.
