Dear All,

Firstly I would like to wish you a happy new year on behalf of the WJPS team. Hopefully you had a great Christmas, and maybe even got to go to a panto? "Oh no we didn't". Anyway its 2007 already, and we hope that it will be an exciting year for us and you. We have lots of developments going on over the next few months which hopefully you will be able to get involved in.

Latest Development News:

Some of you may have been having a play with our latest version of the software that is currently in a Beta stage. It looks at the moment though this wont roll out but will become part of a larger project. Over the next couple of months we are intending to launch a number of new product. We will be keeping the current version of CSMD, but this will be know as CSMD Standard, updated will be made to this to make it run faster etc but functionality wise this will now stay fairly stable. We will then be launching a new version of CSMD know as CSMD Advanced. This version will allow you to preset many of the track variables when creating the track. It will also allow you to start the start and end of the track, including fades in and out which will all auto run. This version will also allow you to save upto 2 separate fades per track making the software even more versatile than before.

Our final change / update will see the role out of portable versions of the software. Sometimes refered to as U3 software (<http://www.u3.com>). At this stage it is too early to tell but we believe the software will run on any memory stick or removeable hard drive and you will not need a U3 memory stick. This will allow you to install the software onto a memory stick, hopefully one larger enough to take all the tracks for a show, setup the show on this memory stick at home or wherever you choose, and then pull the memory stick out of the machine, goto your venue, stick it in and away you go, the software and tracks will be all ready for you to use.

These changes will be rolled out over the next few months and hopefully improve your satisfaction of the software even more. As always these changes have come about because of our users input, and we would like to continue hearing from you with your experiences of the software or your ideas for the ways in which we could update the software. As usual we will be rolling out free updates for the software, but if you want to upgrade from the Standard version to Advanced there will be a small charge. Details of these charges will be released closer to the time.

Current Offers:

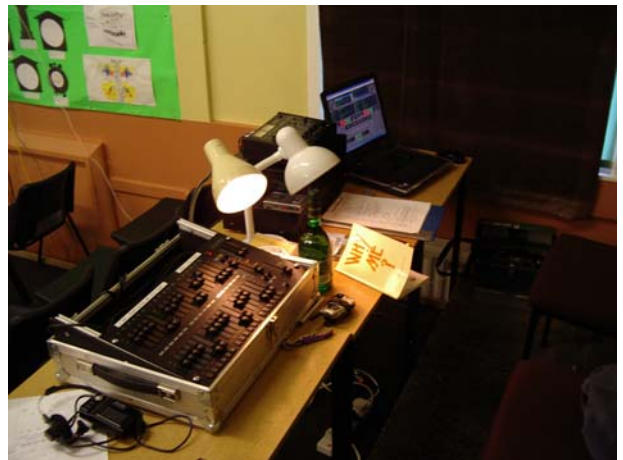
Unfortunately at the moment we don't have any special offers on but over the coming months we aim to bring you some amazing offers as always.
